## Steps to Replicate

1. Log into **Blackboard Learn Ultra Experience** as an instructor
2. Create and access a course > Create a test > In **Test Settings**, under the Evaluation options, enable the 'Peer review option' and enter the Peer review due date > **Save** > Make sure the test is visible for students.
3. Enroll two students in the course
4. Log in as one of the students and attempt the test
5. After the Peer review due date set in step 2 passes, login as the other student
6. Navigate to the test > Under **Assigned Peer Reviews**, click on 'Start peer reviews'
7. Write a review in the Feedback text box > Click on **Save Draft**

**Observed Behavior:** While the student is still on the same page, they can see the review.

1. Navigate from the review page

**Observed Behavior:** Under the test Details & Information, you can see Peer Review 1: Saved on (saved draft date and time completed on step 7)

1. Click on the available peer review

## Observed Behavior:

The saved draft feedback disappears.

## Expected Behavior:

The saved draft feedback appears.
