

Number of Submissions to Grade in the Global "Grades" Page in Ultra Navigation does not Change for Original Courses Manually Created Columns.

Description

The number of submissions to grade in the global "Grades" page in Ultra Navigation does not change when the instructor grade submissions of manually created columns in the Grade Center of an Original course.

The issue only affects **Original View Courses** in **Ultra Base Navigation** enabled **Blackboard Learn** environments.

Steps to Replicate

1. Log into **Blackboard Learn** as an Instructor
2. Access an **Original View Course** that has multiple students enrolled
3. Go to the **Full Grade Center** and create a new **manual column**, points possible does not matter
4. Click at "**Grades**" on the Ultra Base Navigation menu (left-menu) and scroll to the course you just created the new manual column
5. Observe the number of students that need grading e.g., "**6 to grade**"
6. Navigate to the **Full Grade Center** of the Original course and give students any grade for the new manual column created
7. Click at "**Grades**" on the Ultra Base Navigation menu (left-menu) again
8. Note that the number of student submissions to grade does not reduce even after grading some students within the Full Grade Center

Observed Behavior: The "to grade" number did NOT change after the instructor grade submissions.

Expected Behavior: The "to grade" number changes after the instructor grade submissions to reflect the actual number of submissions to grade.

Summary

The number of submissions to grade in the global "Grades" page in Ultra Navigation does not change when the instructor grade submissions of manually created columns in the Grade Center of an Original course.
