

In Ultra Courses Granular Copied Assessments Cannot Have Group Settings Changed From "No Group" to Individual Submission

Description

In the Ultra Course View, when the user tries to copy a group assignment into a new course, and wants to keep the assignment content and make it an individual assignment, as s/he deletes the groups, the assessment settings will not save.

Resolution Workaround

1. In the Assessment settings, click on "No Group" in Assigned groups section, create one Group and Save the page. No enrollments or further settings are required. *This could be done either in the original course (before copying) or destination course (after copying).*
 2. In "Assigned groups" section, it will display "1 group" instead of "No Groups". Then do click over the Trash Icon.

Steps to Replicate

1. Log into **Blackboard Learn Ultra Experience** as an administrator
2. Create a Ultra Course (1) view
3. In the Course (1), create a new Assessment
4. Go to Assessment settings, click at "Assign to groups" in "Assigned groups" section
5. Save the "Assigned groups" page without making any changes or creating any group
6. Then the "Assigned groups" section must display "No Groups"
7. As an Administrator, create another Ultra Course(2) view
8. In the new Course(2), go to **Course Content** > Click on symbol " + " > select **Copy Content** option.
9. Copy the Assessment with **No Groups** assigned from Course(1)
10. Once the copy is completed, go to the **Assessment Settings**
11. In the "Assigned groups" section, click over the Trash Icon

Observed Behavior:

"No Groups" setting is not cleared and the assessment will not be updated to individual submissions. No error message is displayed.

Expected Behavior:

"No Groups" should be cleared and updated to "Assign to groups". The Assessment should be updated to Individual submissions setting.

Summary

In Ultra course view, when granular copying an assessment to a new course, it cannot have Group settings changed from "No Group" to Individual submission because the assessment settings will not save.
