1. Log into **Blackboard Learn Ultra Experience** as an instructor
2. Access an Ultra Course
3. Create a **Learning Module** with **Force Sequence** enabled
4. Add 1 Ultra Document with 1 Knowledge Check inside the **Learning Module**
5. Create any 2 additional contents inside the same **Learning Module**
6. Outside the Learning Module, using the **Copy Content** in the course copy the same **Learning Module**
7. Turn on **Progress Tracking** in the course
8. Log in as a student
9. Open the course and click on **Start** in the **Learning Module**
10. Click on **Next** in the Learning Module navigation and close the window
11. Click on **Continue** in the same Learning Module

Observed Behavior:

The student is able to view the Knowledge check question as an assessment panel.

The student should continue from the content where the Learning module window was closed.
