In an Original Course assignment, the inline grading text annotation cannot be pasted when copying from the submitted document. It does not allow it unless a character is entered first (or if the user does ctrl+shift+v).

Steps to Replicate

1. Log into **Blackboard Learn Ultra Experience** as an administrator
2. Go to the **Admin Panel > Course > Create a new Original Course**
3. Enroll a Student and create an assignment
4. As a student submit an attempt by uploading an MS Word file (make sure it has some text)
5. As the instructor, go into the **Grade Center > Full Grade Center** and access the attempt
6. From the document itself, copy some text (one word is enough)
7. Click on the "T" icon to access the **Text Annotation** box
8. Do CTRL+V to paste the text copied
