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## Steps to Replicate

1. Log into **Blackboard Learn Ultra Experience** as an administrator
2. Create an Ultra course
3. Access the course and enroll an instructor and two students (sb\_student01 and sb\_student02)
4. Go to **Discussions > Add** > Put a title to the discussion (e.g. Title1)
5. Click on **Discussion Settings > Grade Discussion**
6. Make the Discussion Visible to Students
7. Log in as Student01 and access the Course Discussion and add a comment to the discussion thread
8. Log in as Student02 and access the Course Discussion and add a comment to the discussion thread
9. Log in as the instructor and access course
10. Click on **Gradebook > Title1**
11. Access Student01 attempt
12. Click the (+) to add Student Feedback of "Student01 your comments described the situation as expected." > **Save**
13. Move to the next student's attempt "Student02" by clicking on right arrow towards the top of the current page
14. Click the (+) to add Student Feedback of "Student02 your comments described the situation as expected." > **Save**
15. Move to the previous student's attempt "Student01" and view the Feedback
