Steps to Replicate

1. Log into **Blackboard Learn Ultra Experience** as an administrator
2. Create an Ultra course
3. Create 3 Tests. Use multiple-choice questions so that they will get automatic 100% scores
4. Create 3 Assignments with a discussion category
5. Ensure tests and assignments/discussions have percentage grading
6. Set the overall grade to Weighted and assign the following values:
 - Discussion: 10%
 - Test: 55%
 - Homework: 20%
 - Presentation: 15%
 - Assign 0s to the rest.
 - Overall grade presented in percentage.
7. As a student, take the 3 tests and comment on one assignment/discussion
8. As the instructor grade that one discussion and assign the maximum points to another one
9. Go to the Gradebook and check on the overall grade for grid view, list view and download the Gradebook and check the overall grade column

Observed Behavior:

The grid view shows 99.99% instead of 100% as in the List view and the gradebook downloaded.

Expected Behavior:

Grid view, list view and gradebook downloaded show 100% as the overall grade for the test student.
