## Description

In the Content Editor when a user selects an object such as an image or attachment, and then types some text or selects another object button it should replace the object with the new object or text. If the user selects the Insert link button and types a Link URL without any Link Text by default it will add a link where the URL and the Link Text are the same.

In this case, when a user selects an object like an image or attachment and then selects the 'Insert link' button and types a Link URL without any Link Text, it will not add the link.

  3. Add a Link Text.

## Steps to Replicate

1. Log into **Blackboard Learn Ultra Experience** as an instructor
2. Click on + Document
3. Click on **Add Content**
4. Click on the 'Add Image' button
5. Select any image and click on **Save**
6. Click on the image to select it
7. Click on the 'Link' button
8. Set a Link URL only and click on **Insert**

## Observed Behavior:

The image is gone but the link is not there.

## Expected Behavior:

The Image should be replaced with a link.
