This issue affects visual representation of styles and accessibility when creating new content.

## Steps to Replicate

**Prerequisite:** an environment with version 3900.121 and 3900.118 for comparing.

1. Log into **Blackboard Learn Ultra Experience** as an administrator
2. Create an Ultra Course and access it
3. Create a document and type:

Title  
Header  
Subheader  
Paragraph

1. Set for each row the Text style

## Observed Behavior:

The bottom margin of Title (h2) is bigger in 3900.121 than in Title (h4) in 3900.118.

The header (h3) in 3900.121 uses font with Serifs.

**Expected Behavior:**

If the shift between text styles and their corresponding headers was intentional, their font-family should remain same (Sans-Serif).
