## Description

This known issue is experienced on adding users to groups after an assignment has been posted and when a group attempt already exists. Instructors can grade the group attempt; however, newly added group members do not receive that grade. Although a grade can be entered for the added member, it cannot be posted.

## Steps to Replicate

1. Log into **Blackboard Learn Ultra Experience** as an instructor
2. Navigate into a course with multiple users enrolled
3. Select **Add** > select **Create** > click **Assignment**
4. Open **Assignment Settings** > select **Assign to groups**
5. Add a user to a group > click **Save**
6. Save the assignment making it **Visible to Students**
7. Log in as the student and submit an attempt, then log back in as the instructor
8. Select the **Group** link under the assignment
9. Add another user to a group and observe the warning provided in the interface
10. Select **Save** > click the **Gradebook** > select the assignment > click the group - attempt shows only one member
11. Grade the group attempt and post the grade
12. Since the added user does not receive the posted grade attempt to set it manually
13. Click the two members (Hide) link
14. Set an **Override Grade** for the second group member
15. Post the grade

## Observed Behavior:

The post button returns and the grade cannot be posted.

**Expected Behavior:**

The grade is posted.
